IRA Charitable Rollover

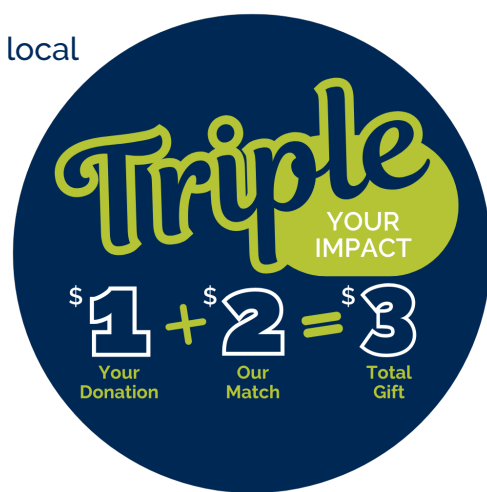
Beginning at age 70 ½, individuals can make a tax-free gift and avoid taxes on transfers up to \$108,000 from their IRA to PCCF. They can satisfy their required minimum annual distribution, reduce taxable income, and give to one or more favorite charitable causes.

Investing in Porter County Children

It is never too early to start saving for a child or grandchild's education. PCCF believes strongly in the importance of education after high school. Through "Seeds of Promise" the Foundation has allocated resources to ensure every baby born to a Porter County family will start life with funds already dedicated to furthering their education.
